2-5 DAY FORECAST ISSUED SATURDAY 18TH MARCH 2017: Sunday night will be fairly cloudy with showers. Monday is expected to see more persistent rain for a time with showers later on. Monday night will have a few showers turning wintry later on bringing the chance of a light covering of snow on the highest routes. Tuesday is expected to have a few showers, mostly later on. The remainder of the period will have showers or some longer spells of rain. These could turn wintry at times on high ground but confidence is low. 6-10 DAY FORECAST: Thursday should see any rain or showers clear to leave it generally dry for several days with broken cloud. Chilly, with RSTs dipping quite low for a time at the end of the nights. The end of the weekend and start of the following week may see it turn milder and less settled.
